

PFP 2023

Sec 4N(A) students can apply for the PFP after the release of the O-level Results in 2023, if they fulfil ALL the following requirements:

- 1. ELMAB3 raw aggregate score of 12 points or better (excluding CCA bonus pts)
- 2. At least a Grade 3 in EL AND Math Syll. A / Add. Math
- 3. At least a Grade 3 in the relevant subjects



PFP 2023

Sec 4N(A) students who have sat for GCE O-level subjects are allowed to combine the N & O-level Examination Results:

O-level Grade	Aggregate Point for PFP
A1 – B3	1
B4 – C6	2
D7	3



All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last day of January 2023.




